

## **Agnieszka Chlon-Dominczak**

Agnieszka Chlon-Dominczak is a Councillor to Minister in the Ministry of Regional Development in Poland. Until the end of 2006, she was a Head of Economic Analyses and Forecasting Department in the Ministry of Labor and Social Policy. From December 2004 until November 2005 she was an Undersecretary of State in the Ministry of Social Policy, where her responsibilities included the oversight of the social insurance system. She is the member of Social Protection Committee of the European Council and Employment, Labor and Social Policy Committee of the OECD.

Chlon-Dominczak has several years of experience on the core team in the Office of the Plenipotentiary for Social Security Reform that designed and implemented the new Polish pension system. As a member of this team, she filled a number of roles, including Acting Deputy Executive Director, financial and legislative consultant and public education consultant. As part of her duties, she helped drafting the major laws of the reform of the pension system, as well as supporting decrees.

As a consultant, she participated in numerous activities related to pension reforms in the region of Central and Eastern Europe, cooperating with the World Bank, ILO and the OECD. She participated in numerous conferences on pension issues, where she shared the experience of the Polish pension reform with other participants. She is an author and co-author of many publications in the field of pensions and labor markets.
