Gonzalo Capriolo is chief economist at the Ministry of Finance of Republic of Slovenia. He is delegate of Slovenia to the Economic Policy Committee of the Council of Europe. He is lecturer at the Center of Excellence in Finance in Ljubljana. Research and publications while working at the Ministry include various topics such as the impact of pension reform on fiscal stance, monetary integration, tax reform, impact of capital inflows, current account sustainability, fiscal stance and debt sustainability, public sector debt management framework, government's debt portfolio management, government accounts classification. On pension reform he wrote two papers: the Need of Pension Reform in Slovenia and Design of the funded scheme: Options and constraints. He coordinated the preparation of a World Bank model for the assessment of the 1999 pension reform in Slovenia.

He holds a master from Columbia University (New York, USA) and Master in Economics from El Colegio de Mexico (Mexico City, Mexico).
