Mr. Haker is working since 2002 as an economist at the Federal Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs in Germany in the division "Basic Questions and Methodologies Financing the Old Age Pension System, Actuarial Mathematics".

He is responsible for preparing short-, medium- and long-term projections of the financial status of the public pension scheme and the assessment of legal measures against the background of the long term sustainability of the pension system.

Before joining the ministry, Haker was senior project manager at the Prognos AG, a consultancy services company. In 2003 he was member of the secretary of the so-called "Rürup-Commission", an expert group that developed proposals for reform of the social security system with the aim to strengthen the financial sustainability. He is a member of the Working Group on Ageing of the European Commission.
